

To ensure your visit is a happy one, please observe the following rules and regulations pertaining to camping at Exhibition Park In Canberra (EPIC):

1. Exhibition Park In Canberra (EPIC) is owned and managed by the ACT Government.
2. Check-in is between 7am and 5pm Monday to Friday, with check-out being by 12noon. Departures after this time will incur an additional day's site fee. For after hours assistance, please phone 0418 630 034.
3. A minimum stay of one night and a maximum stay of up to 28 days are permitted. Return stays are permitted 28 days after your previous occupancy.
4. A bucket or other suitable receptacle, which should not be allowed to overflow, must be used for collection of waste water and emptied at the "Grey Water" dump points located within the Cotter Campground and Wagtail Way (please refer to attached map). Overnight pails and/or cassette toilets may only be emptied in the "Black Water" dump pit located in the Cotter Campground. Under no circumstances is black water to be disposed of in the Campground ablution block.
5. Exhibition Park Corporation and/or the ACT Government shall not be liable for any loss or damage to your property by theft or for personal injury.
6. Please keep your site clean and tidy and ensure there are no obstructions on paths or roads.
7. NO NOISE is permitted after 9pm. We ask that all visitors observe the basic rules of camping and caravanning, i.e. no loud radios or noise at early or late hours. Excessive noise will not be tolerated.
8. In the interest of safety, please ensure that your children are accompanied to the showers and toilets.
9. Please observe a maximum 10kph speed limit at all times.
10. Dogs are permitted at EPIC provided they are kept on a lead and under control at all times. While dogs can be exercised within the grounds, please ensure that droppings are disposed of properly.
11. Pets are not permitted in the shower/toilet or laundry facilities.
12. In the interest of your pet's safety and wellbeing, animals are not to be left unattended in caravans, campervans, motor homes or tents at any time.
13. Please check with EPIC Management on the use of barbeques as Fire Restrictions may apply. No open fires are permitted at any time.
14. All visitors are asked to keep toilet, shower and laundry facilities as clean and tidy as possible.
15. In our commitment to conserve water, please limit your shower to 3 minutes. Due to water restrictions in the ACT, washing of vehicles, caravans/campervans or motor homes is not permitted.
16. Litter must always be placed in one of the many bins provided around EPIC. The irresponsible discard of litter, by any persons will not be tolerated.
17. Please do not leave taps running or put articles likely to cause obstructions into basins, sinks or toilets.
18. Smoking is not permitted in the shower/toilet or laundry facilities.
19. No tent, caravan, campervan or motor home must have a greater number of occupants than the specified number of berths.
20. One tent and vehicle is permitted per site.
21. For your safety and to conform to ACT Government requirements, only 15amp power cords with 15amp terminals and a maximum length of 10 metres are allowed. An approved circuit breaker and residual current device are necessary to provide power to sites.
22. EPIC is committed to providing a safe environment for all users. Should you observe or experience anything that you feel compromises health and safety, please report this to EPIC Management as soon as possible. (After hours contact: Phone: 0418 630 034.)
23. EPIC Management reserves the right to ask guests who contravene these rules and regulations or, who in any other way are behaving in a manner likely to cause distress or nuisance to other visitors, to leave the park immediately. In these circumstances your stay ceases with no refund given and we shall not be liable for any extra costs incurred by you.
24. If you have a complaint during your visit please bring it to the attention of EPIC Management immediately. If you wish to pursue the matter following your departure, please write to us within 28 days.
